CATEGORIES: We are accepting three categories:

- 1) Artists/crafters selling handmade products/artifact collectors/book authors; \$40 per booth*;
A limited number of crafters in each media will be accepted to prevent duplication of items.
- 2) Non-profit** entities who want to sell products; \$40 per booth*;
- 3) Non-selling (i.e. historical/educational display; “non-profit/information-only” display). No charge

****Non-profit means your organization holds a 501(C) status from the IRS and the State of Tennessee**

1. _____ Craft or Artist (specify type) _____
Category 1 artists and crafters are required to submit a photo of a sample of their craft or art with application.
2. _____ Non-profit, selling.
3. _____ Non-selling educational display (“historic artifacts, non-profit information, educational exhibit”, etc.). **Limited to five applicants, first-come, first served.**

Craft Vendors may not sell food or drink.

***EARLY ENTRY DISCOUNT:** Category 1 exhibitors (see description above) who reserve/pay for booth space before Saturday, July 30, 2011, may deduct \$5 (pay only \$35). **Early entry must be postmarked by this date. Applications after July 30 accepted only for full fee payment (\$40) and as long as space permits.**

COST: This is a straight fee only opportunity (no commissions, or combinations of commissions and fees). You may send check or money order, payable to “CCC-Louie Bluie Music & Art Festival“. Sorry, no credit cards accepted.

TENTS: This festival is an outdoor event. All vendors must be under a tent because weather is a factor. All spaces approximately 10’ x 10’. All vendors must provide their own tent, display table, chairs, and signs. Vendors must erect their own tent (set up times to be determined). No funeral home tents. If your tent is larger than 10 x 10 you will need to rent two spaces.

PRODUCTS: The Louie Bluie Music & Art Festival is dedicated to artists and artisans whose products are created or crafted by hand, reflecting skills of the individual. **Imported or commercially produced**

products are not appropriate. Sale of any live animal or plants is prohibited. Candidates for political office or representatives of political causes or parties may not qualify as a vendor. Signage announcing SALE, CLOSEOUT, or CLEARANCE is prohibited.

RETURNED CHECKS: There will be a \$30 NSF fee charged for returned checks. This fee, **plus** the full booth fee must then be paid in cash or money order before application deadline in order to reserve space.

CANCELLATION: Category 1 exhibitors (see description above) who cancel by Wed. Aug. 31, will be refunded half of the fee paid. Cancellations after this date mean your fee is **forfeited, no refund.**

PLEASE READ: Exhibitor, artist, crafter, non-profit or any organization contracting for or using booth space shall and will indemnify and hold harmless the Campbell Culture Coalition, Cove Lake State Park, Friends of Cove Lake State Park, Cumberland Trail State Park, Friends of the Cumberland Trail and any and all persons acting as festivals organizers, promoters, volunteers, etc. from and against any and all liability, claims, thefts, demands, expenses, fees, fines and penalties, suits, proceedings, actions, and causes of action of any and every kind and nature arising or growing out of or in any way connected with exhibitor/artist/crafter/non-profit's use of booth space during said Festival. Exhibitor/artist/crafter/non-profit entity acknowledges and agrees to abide by all rules and regulations.
